



# Workflow Modifications for Increasing HPV Vaccination Rates - DelVAX Reports

The Community Preventive Services Task Force recommends utilizing Immunization Information Systems based on strong evidence of increasing vaccination rates.

<b>Who Should Be Trained?</b>	VFC Coordinator for each provider’s office, AND
	<b>The Office Manager and/or the representative(s)</b> for each provider who oversee the following type of tasks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Running reports</li> <li>Setting office workflow expectations</li> <li>Establishing and overseeing office policies</li> </ul>

<b>Report Options</b>	<b>Patient Roster</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A patient roster in DelVAX lists active and inactive patients alphabetically by last name.</li> </ul>
	<b>Inactivate Patient Reports</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This report provides a quick way to view a patient roster and mark patients as Inactive - Lost to Follow-Up or Inactive - No Longer a Patient.</li> </ul>
	<b>Coverage Assessment Snapshot Report</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Snapshot reports display number and percentage of patients who have met certain immunization criteria.</li> <li>There are a number of reports available including: AFIX reports, IQIP reports, Not UTD Patient Listing, Single Antigen Assessment, Missed Opportunities, among others.</li> </ul>
	<b>Reminder Recall Report</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Reminders and recalls are used to notify the user of upcoming vaccinations needed (reminders) and overdue vaccinations (recalls).</li> </ul>
	<b>Patient Details with Services Report</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Patient Detail with Services Report is used to produce a report of patient vaccinations that have been given by a selected provider/clinic meeting the selection criteria.</li> </ul>

## Practice Responsibilities

- ✓ Perform roster clean-up and patient inactivation quarterly
- ✓ Ensure appropriate staff receive DelVAX training
- ✓ Routinely monitor immunization status of patients utilizing DelVAX reports
