Using DelVAX Reports to Improve Immunization Coverage Rates

Do you or your staff need Delaware Immunization Program training? The Division of Public Health's (DPH) communicable disease regulations mandate that all immunizations that are administered in the State of Delaware must be reported to the DPH Immunization Information System, known as DelVAX. The Delaware Immunization Program has contracted with Scientific Technologies Corporation (STC) to offer live, online provider training designed to explore the various uses of selected vaccination reports within DelVAX that can be used to assist in improving immunization coverage rates.

Who should receive DelVAX training?

Vaccines for Children (VFC) Coordinators for each provider AND the Office Manager and/or representative(s) for each provider who oversee the following type of tasks:

- Running Reports
- Setting Office Workflow Expectations
- Establishing & Overseeing Office Policies
