

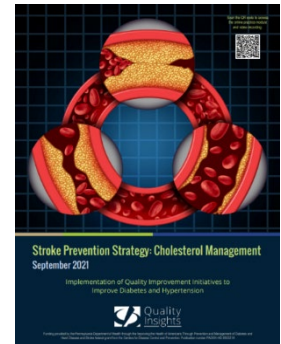
Quality Insights 2021 Cholesterol Management Practice Module
